I will never propose for membership any person not eligible according to our Constitution, nor one whom I know to be unworthy.

I will never make known to any one not authorized to receive it any of the work of this Order, secret or written. Should my affiliation with The Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States cease, in any way, I will consider this pledge as binding outside the Order as though I had remained a member of the same. All this I promise and pledge upon the honor of a true Comrade and a citizen of our great republic.
